# INFORMATION FOR POLICE ALARM USERS

(Alarm Ordinance Overview)

Chapter 8, Article VII, Sections 44 [-490, of the Mesquite City Code requires that ALARM USERS, (Alarm Sites), in the city, both commercial and residential, except as stated in Section 442 (a) & (b), obtain Police Alarm Permits from the Mesquite Police Department. Police alarm permits may be obtained by payment of a yearly fee of \$40.00.

## PERMITS

1. The yearly (one year) fee for a permit is \$40.00, payable to the City of Mesquite.
2. Permit applications and fees, Payable to the City of Mesquite, should be mailed to:

3. There is no charge for data changes on a current permit.
4. Each alarm system (site) is required to have a permit.
5. No permits or permit numbers will be returned to an applicant. Information will be entered into the alarm database and applications will be filed by address.
6. Renewal notices will be mailed approximately 30 days prior to the expiration date of a permit.

## RESPONSIBILITIES OF ALARM USERS

The Permit Holder, to whom the permit is issued, shall be responsible for compliance with the regulations of the alarm ordinance.

## THE PERMIT HOLDER SHALL ENSURE THAT:

1. The Police Department is furnished current information regarding persons to be contacted in case of an alarm activation.
2. The alarm mechanism is adjusted to suppress false indications due to:
  - a. Flashes of light;
  - b. Wind noise caused by rattling or vibration of windows or doors;
  - c. Vehicular noise;
  - d. Electrical power fluctuations;
  - e. Other forces unrelated to an actual emergency.
3. An authorized person responds to the scene of an alarm, within 30 minutes, if requested to do so by the Police Department.
4. Audible alarms are adjusted so that the alarm will sound for NO LONGER than 15 minutes, and must be manually reset before sounding again.
5. The alarm must not be manually activated for any reason other than the occurrence of the event that the system was intended to report (i.e., activating a robbery alarm for any reason other than an actual robbery).
6. When an alarm signal is sent by your alarm system, your monitoring company should call Mesquite Police Communications at: (855)-879-6964.

## VIOLATIONS:

1. A person who operates an alarm system without a permit violates the City Ordinance and may be fined up to \$250.00 per day or per occurrence of violation.
2. A person who operates an alarm system with a permit may be cited to Municipal Court for violation of the following:
  - a. Permitting an audible alarm to sound for more than 15 minutes.
  - b. Failing to require a manual reset.
  - c. Intentionally activating a false alarm, resulting in Police response.
3. A permit may be suspended for:
  - a. Any false statement or misrepresentation of a material fact made by an applicant for the purpose of obtaining an alarm permit or renewal, or while making a change thereto, shall be sufficient cause for refusal to grant, or suspension of, a permit.
  - b. Violation of any of the City Ordinance sections dealing with responsibilities of the alarm user.
  - c. Failure to keep information current on alarm applications.
  - d. Failing to respond to an alarm within thirty (30) minutes, when required to do so by the Police Department.
  - e. Failure to pay assessed service fees within thirty (30) days.
  - f. Emitting more than eight (8) false alarms within a twelve month period.
4. It is the responsibility of the permit holder to be familiar with the City Ordinance.

## SERVICE FEES

An Alarm user shall be subject to fines, depending on the number of false alarms within the preceding 12 month period, based upon the following schedule:

False Alarm Fines: Registered location  
Burglary/Robbery/Panic - Residential/Commercial Fine Schedule

|-----------------------------|-----------------|
| • 1st to 3rd false alarm    | : No fine       |
| • 4th to 5th false alarm    | : \$50.00       |
| • 6th to 7th false alarm    | : \$75.00       |
| • 8th false alarm and above | : \$100.00 each |

All false alarm invoices will be due within 30 days from the invoice date.

## AN ALARM WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED "FALSE" IF IT IS DETERMINED THAT THE ALARM WAS CAUSED BY:

1. Natural or man-made catastrophe;
2. Criminal activity;
3. Severe weather, causing damage to the premises.
